
- Create Comstat package with crime statistics to be reviewed weekly by command staff.







Mapping and Probability






Deployment Zones



Southeast District Robbery Analysis

Week 9 Analysts Notes

- NED had the most robberies (47), SWD had the least robberies (9) SED was ranked 4th for robberies for the 28 day period (27).
- > In the past 28 day period, SED has increased in the total number of robberies by 42% (27).
- SED YTD Robbery total has increased 11% (61) in comparison to last year.
- In the past 28 day SED had a total of 27 robberies
 - o Of the 27 incidents:
 - 4 were residential robberies
 - 3 were commercial robberies
 - 18 were street robberies
 - 2 of the 27 were domestic related
 - 112B04636, 112B09630, 112B11607, 112C01776 cases noticed as being domestic violence related.
- Monday and Wednesday had the greatest number of robberies (5).
- Most robberies occurred between the hours of 1200hrs and 1600hrs (6) and 0100 and 0300hrs (6).
- 3X11 Shift had majority of the robberies (10).
- Post 212 and 223 had the most robberies in the 28 day period (4).
 - In Post 212, 2 occurred on Wednesday, 2 occurred during the 3x11 Shift and 2 during the 7x3 Shift.
 - In Post 223, 1 incident occurred on Sunday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, 4 occurred during the 11x7 Shift.
- > 5 incidents involved a firearm and 4 incidents involved a knife




