Social Disorder

- 1 homicide (2005)
- 746 calls for service for narcotics since 2000, particularly in 2000- 2003 and 2005-2007;
- Total of thirteen 911 calls for shootings since 2000;
- Concentrations of juvenile arrests in 2000 (mix of offenses) and 2006 (predominantly drug-related)

Surrounding Context

- Residential properties;

Routine Opportunity Areas

- Parallel parked cars with little to no street lighting further along on the block;
- Narrow alleyway may provide cover for illicit activities

Physical Disorder

- Chronically vacant properties on the 500 block of N. Glover Street;
- Increasing number of 311 CitiStat calls for service for trash beginning in 2007

Built Environment & Design

- Possibly inadequate lighting at night;
- Narrow, pedestrian-friendly alley that connects to N/S alleyways on both sides

Streets and Alleys

- Glover is a residential, low traffic, one-way street;
- McElderry/Jefferson Alley is narrow and provides a shortcut to N/S running alleys

Sense of Community

- Low rates of owner-occupancy on Glover Street
