Social Disorder

- 198 calls for service for narcotics since 2000, particularly in 2000 and 2001;
- Total of three 911 calls for shootings since 2000;
- High concentration of juvenile arrests for drug-related offenses in 2001

Surrounding Context

- Residential properties;
- Church on NE corner of intersection

Routine Opportunity Areas

- Parallel parked cars with little to no street lighting further along on the block;
- Bus stop on SE corner of intersection (#13)

Physical Disorder

- Chronically vacant properties on the 500 block of N. Milton Avenue;
- High number of 311 CitiStat calls for service for trash in 2010, specifically at 500 N. Milton Street

Built Environment & Design

- Possibly inadequate lighting at night;
- Wide sidewalks for easy foot traffic

Streets and Alleys

- Milton Street is a residential, two-way, moderate traffic street;
- Jefferson Street is a lower traffic, two-way residential street with bus traffic

Sense of Community

- High rates of owner-occupancy on east side of the 500 block of Milton Avenue
