Crime and Safety



Crime and Safety

Baltimore City has made improving the safety of its residents and visitors a priority. BNIA-JFI tracks several indicators designed to track both adult and juvenile crime and safety in Baltimore City and its neighborhoods. A summary of these crime and safety indicators and their change over the past several years is described below.

Domestic Violence

- In 2008, the number of 911 calls reporting incidences of domestic violence was slightly below 40 incidences per 1,000 persons. From 2003 to 2008, the greatest decrease in calls of domestic violence was in Dickeyville/Franklintown (-24.5%), and the greatest increase was in Clifton-Berea (20%).

Juvenile Crime

- While the juvenile arrest rate for the City has decreased from 140.3 juvenile arrests per 1,000 juveniles in 2003 to 108.8 in 2008, juvenile arrests in some CSAs such as Downtown/Seton Hill, Clifton-Berea, and Orangeville/East Highlandtown have risen dramatically.
- While overall juvenile crimes decreased, the rate of juvenile arrests for violent offenses nearly doubled from 2003 (9.6 juveniles arrested per 1,000 juveniles) to 2008 (18.7 juveniles arrested per 1,000 juveniles).
- The rate of juveniles arrested for drug-related offenses decreased overall from 2003 to 2008, but increased from 2007 to 2008.
- In 2008, 68.6% of juveniles arrested had committed a previous offense.


Adult Crime

- Despite a slight decline in the Part 1 crime rate¹ in Baltimore City between 2003 (79.4 per 1,000 persons) and 2008 (78.3 per 1,000 persons), from 2007 (62.9 per 1,000 persons) to 2008 (78.3 per 1,000 persons) the Part 1 crime rate in Baltimore City

¹ Part I offenses include murder, aggravated assault, rape, attempted rape, burglary, larceny, and auto theft.


increased. The CSA with the highest overall crime rate was Downtown/Seton Hill with approximately 73% of the crimes in this CSA being either larceny or common assault.

- For Baltimore City, the violent crime rate fell from 19.8 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2003 to 16.3 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2008. The greatest decreases in violent crimes were in Fells Point and in Poppleton/The Terraces/Hollins Market.
